Options and Costs

Option 1: Full Pilgrimage 28.8 – 4.9.11

The pilgrimage is *free* however pilgrims will need their own personal funds for meals. They will need to pay for the coach journey home after the York Minster service. A £20 non-refundable deposit is paid on booking to go towards petrol costs of the minibus.

All accommodation will be in church buildings. Pilgrims will need to provide their own sleeping bags and sleeping mats. Meals and washing facilities will vary in each location. Pilgrims are welcome to arrange their own B&B accommodation but will need to be at the setting off point on time each morning.

Option 2: 1st Weekend 28-29.8.11

Option 2 will be part of the main pilgrimage but will need to make their own food/accommodation arrangements and are responsible for their travel home on the Monday. Can be booked with Option 3.

Option 3: Final Weekend 2-4.9.11

Option 3 will be part of the main pilgrimage but will need to make their own food/accommodation arrangements and are responsible for travel to Tadcaster on the Friday. Can be booked with Option 2.

Transport

A minibus will accompany pilgrims to carry luggage and to give lifts where necessary.

Transport back to Todmorden from York at the end of the pilgrimage can also be provided.

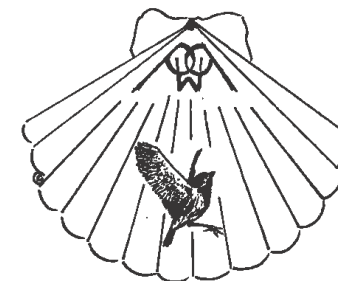
